

RULES FOR THE USE OF THE GARDENS

- a) The Gardens are available for use from 8.00am to 10:30pm, but not outside this period. Children shall not be permitted in the gardens after dusk or 9.00pm whichever is earlier.
- b) No animals are permitted in the Gardens. If an animal does nevertheless enter the Gardens and fouls them the owner must promptly remove the fouling concerned.
- c) Radios and music shall not be played in the Gardens. In addition, noise must not be made which would inconvenience other users or be heard in the houses or flats around the Gardens. Shouting from windows down to the Gardens is not permitted.
- d) Cooking, barbequing and the preparation of food is not permitted in the Gardens.
- e) For health and safety reasons only plastic glasses should be used in the Gardens.
- f) Litter should not be dropped or left in the Gardens.
- g) Users must not walk on the planted areas and must take care to avoid damaging the flowers, shrubs and trees.
- h) Bicycles and tricycles should not be ridden in the Gardens.
- i) The playing of ball games is restricted to young children only. Any ball games that cause or have the potential to cause damage to the Gardens, the flowers, shrubs and trees or any property adjoining the Gardens shall not be permitted.
- j) No equipment or personal effects shall be left on the grassed areas of the Gardens.
- k) Parents shall supervise their children whilst they are using the Gardens, and ensure that these Rules are observed and adhered to.
- l) Owners should feel free to make suggestions for the next season's planting, particularly before the commencement of the next calendar year.
