



**Please be aware that a full all out evacuation policy is now
in place in the event of a fire**

London Fire Brigade guidance for building evacuation:

- **Leave your flat or maisonette and close the doors behind you.**
- **Move as quickly but as safely as you can, and don't stop to investigate or pick up valuables.**
- **Use the stairs to make your way out of the building – don't use the lift.**
- **Call 999 as soon as you are safe to do so – don't assume someone else has made the call.**

Please notify us if you need assistance to evacuate the building or reach a place of safety in the event of an emergency evacuation. Such as physical disabilities, hearing and sight loss or limited mobility and those with a temporary condition e.g. heavily pregnant or someone with an injury. Also, if you have any combustible medical equipment etc (such as oxygen) stored and used within your flat.
